
Our high school program is designed to prepare students for entrance into the university and program of their choice without having to complete a foundation year. We provide student-centered learning experiences that cater to the needs of our students.

Our curriculum is based on the US AERO Standards, as well as other US National Standards (for non-AERO subjects) and UAE National Standards (for Ministry of Education subjects). ΑII courses are egual importance, as successful completion of each course earns students a half or full credit towards meeting their graduation requirements.

#### **Advanced Placement (AP)**

Advanced Placement (AP) is a program in the United States and Canada that offers college-level curricula and examinations to high school students. It allows highly motivated students to take university-level courses while still in high school.

High school students at NIS are provided with opportunities to experience a variety of courses that appeal to their educational interests. Teachers at the high school level facilitate students' learning by exposing them to a variety of educational experiences in and out of the classroom, both within the UAE and internationally.



### NIS Secondary Scholarships Prooram

The Nibras International School (NIS) Secondary Scholarships Program aims to motivate and inspire high school students who demonstrate excellence not only in academics but also in various extracurricular pursuits.



The successful scholarship recipients among the Grades 9 and 10 students will receive up to 50% reduction in fees.

The successful scholarship recipients among the Grades 11 and 12 students will receive up to 75% reduction in fees.



### Requirements and Criteria

To be considered for one of our NIS Secondary Scholarships, a high school student must display the following characteristics and must have the following requirements:

A GPA of 3.5 or better and no grade lower than a B in middle and


